Mr. Washington will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1PM-8PM Friday. Mr. Narvell "Bozo" Washington was born September 30, 1933 in Altheimer, AR, the fourth child of Frank and Katie (Hockenhull) Washington. Mr. Washington was employed at the Chevrolet V-8 Engine Plant, retiring in 1980 and was a member of UAW Local #659. He was a faithful member of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church until his illness. He enlisted in the U.S. Army of the United States, serving as an Honor Guard at the White House under President Eisenhower and Nixon, receiving and Honorable Discharge, December 1, 1961. Mr. Washington attended and graduated from C.V. White High School in Lakeview, Arkansas. He also attended AM and N College in Pine Bluff, AR presently known as University of Arkansas.
