Coach Jones was born January 27, 1948 in Memphis, TN, the son of Beatrice Jones and Nathan Jones, Sr. the Jones family later moved to Flint, MI in the 1950's. Coach Jones attended Flint Schools, graduating from Flint Central High School. He was drafted into the US Army Company A-18 Battalion. Coach Jones was successful in various sports. He attended Ferris State University serving as I president (Basieus) of Phi Zeta Chapter. He was #1 coach of Flint Northern Girls Basketball team, coaching and mentoring several girls that made it to the WNBA as well as coaching youths in the surrounding Michigan and Akron areas.
