In 1941, she met and married her husband, Halbert Anthony and was blessed to be in a union with him for 69 years. Nettie worked at A.C. Spark Plugs for a short period of time before going to Cosmetology School. After graduation she worked as a cosmetologist at Green Funeral Home, as well as a beauty shop, which was built on to the back of her home. Nettie was blessed with two biological children from her marriage, but was affectionately called "Mama" by the many foster children she raised and by dear friends whose lives she touched. She served for many years as an Eastern Star member alongside her husband, who was a Mason. Both Nettie and her husband joined Mt.
