March 3, 1922 - March 25, 2020

MOORE, Dea. Noah, Jr. - Age 98, passed away Wednesday, March 25, 2020 at The Landings of Genesee Valley. Family hour 10:00 AM Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, 2115 Coldwater Rd., with funeral service commencing at 10:30 AM, Pastor Michael Pettigrew, officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 AM Tuesday. Dea. Moore will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1:00 PM-8:00 PM Monday.

Deacon Noah Moore Jr. was born March 3, 1922 in Birmingham, Alabama the son of Noah Moore Sr. and Amanda Moore. He passed away peacefully at the Landings of Genesee Valley in Flint, Michigan on March 25, 2020.

Deacon Moore joined the United States Army and was appointed to the 82nd Airborne Infantry Division. He became one of the first black Paratroopers when he was chosen to serve in the 555th Paratroopers Infantry, Also Known As the Triple Nickels during World War II. Following his Honorable Discharge, he joined the Dr. George Washington Carver Post 3791 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. He married Julia Purnell in 1946 and enjoyed his union of 69 years, with his wife until she passed away.

Noah was employed, after his heroic military service, at the Chevrolet V8 Engine Plant, a Division of General Motors for over 30 years. He was a member of UAW local 659. He was a faithful member of St. Paul Missionary

Baptist Church, where he served on the Trustee Board, Usher Board, Deacon Board and sang with the Male Chorus until his health declined. He loved golfing, reading the Bible and listening to Gospel music.
