She was educated in the school system of Blevins, Arkansas, earned her high school diploma later in life in Flint, MI and graduated from Agape Bible College in Birch Run, Michigan. As a young adult Nobie married Floyd Giles, Sr. and to this union eight children were born. They later moved to Flint, Michigan. Mrs. Giles' crowning achievements in life were being a fulltime spiritual wife and loving mother. Her spiritual influence is an ever-present beacon in the development and success of her children. Her devotion to family is also evident in her relationship with her grandchildren, nieces, nephews and whomever she met. She was also very proud of being the "Matriarch" of the Brown and Giles Families. Mrs. Giles was a member of Sweet Home Missionary Baptist Church in Arkansas until she moved to Flint and united

with the Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. Later when the family moved the parents and four younger children united with New Zion Missionary Baptist Church. She was passionate about her church and was a member of the choir, Mission society and served as a Deaconess for many years. She was a gracious woman who loved the Lord and faithfully attended church until her health failed. Mrs. Giles enjoyed sewing, millenary, ceramics and crafts but, most of all she liked going to church service and the spa.
