



Mr. Nolan Jevon Hinton

December 11, 1976 - April 14, 2021

HINTON, Mr. Nolan Jevon - Age 44, passed away Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 4:30 PM Saturday, April 24, 2021 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 5:00 PM Carl Royster, officiating. Family and friends will assemble at the funeral home 4:30 PM Saturday. Mr. Hinton will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday.

Nolan Jevon Hinton was the second of three children born to Robert and Eunice Hinton in Chicago, Illinois. The family moved to Flint, Michigan when Nolan was 13 years old.

Nolan attended Flint Central High School and graduated in 1995. While in High School he established friendships that would endure throughout his life. As a young man he worked for a landscaping company and as an assembler for an automotive supplier. His favorite activities were spending time with his children and playing or watching basketball. Family was very important to Nolan. He was raised in a religious household. The things he learned as a child impacted his view of the world and how he treated people. Although Nolan was not a religious person, the following principles guided his relationships with others.

Psalms 127:3 “Look! Sons are an inheritance from Jehovah; The fruit of the womb is a reward.” (New World Translation of the Holy Scriptures)

Nolan understood he received a precious gift from God when he had children. He believed he was entrusted with the welfare and happiness of his kids and took it very seriously. At times when feeling overwhelmed by his responsibilities as a parent, he prayed for help and tried to teach his kids by example. He was honest when speaking with his kids discussing many topics most would shy away from discussing with their children. He taught his children to be selective about who they choose as friends and encouraged them to be cautious about their use of social media. Nolan felt it was very important to spend time with his kids. He usually dropped them off and picked them up from school. Nolan understood no two children are alike so he worked hard to spend time with each one individually. He knew the most precious things he could give his children were his time, love and affection. Luke 6:35 “On the contrary, continue to love your enemies and to do good and to lend without hoping for anything back; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, for he is kind toward the unthankful and wicked.” (New World Translation of the Holy Scriptures). Nolan was known for being generous and kind towards others. If he helped someone, he did so without expecting anything in return. He maintained relationships that others felt he should have abandoned. Nolan was loyal and did not allow the opinions of others to influence how he felt about someone. He did this because he was working to imitate the God he learned about in his youth and loved. Nolan also believed in leading by example. He was a source of encouragement to his friends. He would often encourage them to be a part of their child’s life and not to allow anything to interfere with that relationship.
