He was a former member of Sacred Heart Church, where he served as the Head Usher and as a reader. Mr. Verdun later became a member of St. John Vianney Catholic Church. He served in the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict. Mr. Verdun was a certified hypnotherapist and counselor. He worked for General Motors and retired from Chevrolet Metal Fab. As a long-term city of Flint resident he was active in the community. Mr. Verdun served as a volunteer for the City of Flint Police and was active in the Police Activities League (PAL). He loved to bicycle. Mr. Verdun was active in the League of Michigan Bicyclists and was an American Wheelman. Mr. Verdun was a man who "Did things his way".
