She was a faithful servant of the Lord during her ministry and continued until the end of her days. Evangelist Houston's accomplishments included become a Certified Nurse Assistant 1 & 2, working for Woodside Church and becoming a School Aide for Cummings Elementary School. She was nominated and became the recipient of the Mother of the Year Award in the City of Flint, Michigan in 1989. Evangelist Houston was a woman of many gifts. 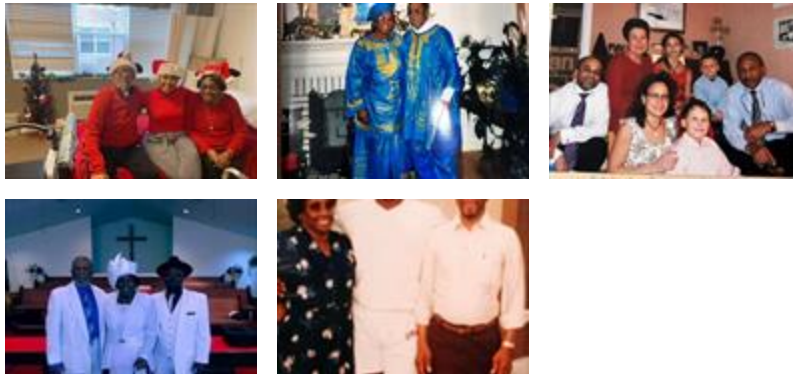

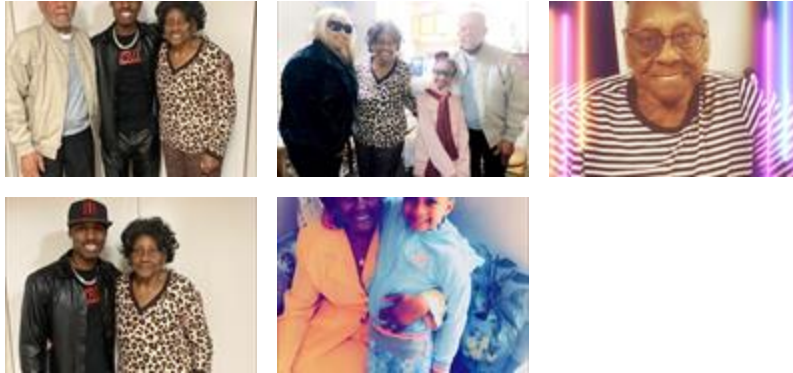

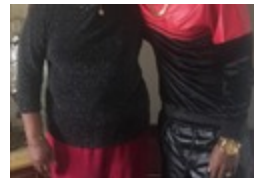
