JONES, Mr. Oliver W. - Age 91, passed away Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at Beaumont Hospital- Royal Oak. Family hour 10:30 AM Friday, September 9, 2016 at Quinn Chapel AME Church, 2101 Lippincott Blvd. Flint, MI., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Rev. Sharinese Jackson officiating, Rev. Oliver W. Jones of Auburn Hills, MI, age 91 died August 31, 2016 at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak, MI. He was born September 3, 1924 in Kansas City, Missouri.

Oliver served his country honorably in the U.S. Army in World War II, with tours of duty in both France and England. He also was a member of Quinn Chapel A.M.E., serving in the Men's Chorus. Mr. Jones also was employed by General Motors in skilled trades and retiring after 38 years of service. He became an avid member of several UAW unions, including #659, #653, #581 and #599, even rising to the elected office of Committeeman.
