DELOACH, Dr. Ollie - Age 81. passed away Friday, September 13, 2019 at her residence.

Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, September 28, 2019 at Upper Room Missionary Baptist Church, 6009 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM, Pastor Alvin Bradford, Host Pastor, Rev. Sidney Deloach, Officiating. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:00 AM Saturday. Dr. Deloach will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM-8:00 PM Friday, September 27, 2019. Mother Ollie Mae Deloach, Dr.h.c., founding First Lady, of the Upper Room Missionary Baptist Church, answered the heavenly call on Friday, September 13, 2019 at her home in Flint Township, Michigan, surrounded by her family.

Mother, was born September 16, 1937 in Starkville, Mississippi to the late Robert and Susie Nelson. She accepted Christ at an early age at Bethel Missionary Baptist Church and was baptized in 1950 by the late, Reverend W. P. Randolph. Ollie Mae graduated from Maben High School, class of 1958 serving as class President and where she pursued her love for basketball. She was awarded a four-year scholarship in basketball and music. Ollie Mae began playing basketball at Natchez Community College where she earned an Associate of Arts Degree. She later matriculated to Alcorn State University; continuing to play basketball and earning a Bachelor of Education Degree. Ollie Mae married the late, Reverend Dr. Roosevelt Deloach on July 27, 1961

in Starkville, Mississippi. They moved to Flint, Michigan in 1963, where they made their home.

As part of the founding pastoral family, she was a faithful and dedicated member of Upper Room Mission-ary Baptist Church since it was established 37 years ago, serving with her late husband, the Reverend Dr. Roosevelt Deloach, Pastor Emeritus until his death.

Mother and her late husband served as the Coordinators of the Wolverine State Convention Pastors and Wives, Widows and Widower's Retreat and were Co-Teachers for the Great Lakes Baptist District Congress of Christian Education Marriage Workshop.

Dr. Ollie Mae Deloach, was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Religious Education Degree from Tennessee School of Religion on May 22, 2005 in recognition of a lifetime committed to promoting learning.

Ollie Mae's first employment in Flint, Michigan, was at J.C. Penney where she was the First Cashier of African American descent. She was later employed by the Flint Public Schools as an Elementary Teacher, retiring after 33 years of service.

Dr. Deloach was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, aunt and friend. Her effervescent spirit would light up a room. Dr. Deloach had a kind heart and her love of the Lord and His people were evident in her loving spirit that touched everyone. She enjoyed the finer things in life, spending time with her family, traveling, gardening, listening to gospel and jazz music, watching women's basketball and sports. Most of all, she was passionate about hearing and studying the Word of God.
