Omar was born October 18, 1942 in Hamtramck, Michigan from the union of Homer Harvey Sr. and Juanita Gregory Harvey. Omar accepted Christ at an early age. She graduated from Farragut Career Academy High School in Chicago, IL. She married Willie Smith Jr. on June 20, 1961 and from this union three children were born. As a resident of Flint for over 50 years, Omar held various positions within the Flint Community School system and retired after 40 years. Omar's dedication to her children, family and friends was unwavering. She enjoyed nurturing her grandchildren, singing, baking, shopping and fellowshiping with her church family. Most of all she loved God, praising Him everywhere! Omar worshipped at True Light Missionary Baptist Church for 33 years where she sang in the choir and faithfully served on the Nursing Guild, Women's Committee, Kitchen Committee, Missionary Board

and filled the gap wherever she was called to duty. She especially loved teaching her Children's Sunday School Class.
