“ I wasn’t able to attend Omar’s services, and although it’s understandable that I couldn’t be there, I don’t feel as though I’ve paid my respects entirely. I was unable to share my experiences and memories of Omar with his friends and family in person, but still feel a need to do it and I guess this is as good a way as any.

My relationship with Omar was first as a professional mentor, who then became one of my closest friends. We were co-workers and part of a community who developed a friendship based on our mutual love of film, music, food, and books. We spent many hours talking about works of art that we enjoyed, and mutually cultivated those interests, expanding both of our horizons. We both had a particular fondness for ‘Pulp Fiction’, and were referred to (both by ourselves and others) as ‘Jules and Vincent.’ We often traded recipes of our favorite dishes, and would always try to one-up each other with our ‘culinary expertise.’

Omar and I also good-naturedly tortured each other about our sports teams, him being a die-hard Tigers and Lions fan and me a huge fan of the Yankees and NY Giants. Regular season match ups had us teasing each other incessantly, and we always hoped for playoff situations where our teams would play each other.

But I think what I loved the most about Omar was his overall demeanor and personality. Omar was non-conformist, a non-traditionalist, and yet was never over-bearing with his beliefs. He was easy-going, peaceful, and content with himself and others around him. He had an inner serenity that I don’t think many people fully acknowledged or aspired to. Even though he had little tolerance for foolishness or deceit, he let people be people to suffer their own fate, and was still willing to lend a hand when they fell. We weren’t afraid to tell each other the truth, and still had the ability to support each other regardless of how we felt about a decision. I learned from Omar, I was educated by him, and I don’t think there’s a more important quality that one could ask from a friend. I’m a better person for knowing him.

To me, he's not entirely gone. I'll terribly miss our mutual love, respect, admiration, and our usual conversations, but there's a piece of him that I'll be able to carry with me. His passing doesn't mean that he's not my friend anymore; he is, and always will be, my friend. Godspeed brother; see you when I see you.
