"Spence" as she was known to friends and family was the daughter of the late Spence and Juliette (Robertson) Pittman. As an infant Spence lost her father, but was blessed with the paternal love of Isadore "Daddy" Jackson. In 1946 she was united in Holy Matrimony to Grady Truss. To this union two children were born, Vance Andrew and Paula Juliet. Spence was a graduate of Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1938", Mott Community College and attended Baker College Business School. She worked for Attorney Joseph Birch before working for the U.S. Government in Washington, DC and the State of Michigan. Spence was a retiree of the City of Flint. She leaves in God's care: daughter, Paula; granddaughters, Kelli and Rozlyn (Christopher) Linder; great-granddaughter, Sydney; brother, Rupert "Billie" (Gwendolyn) Jackson; daughter-in-law, Beverly; sister-in-law, Emma (Truss) Miller; Fuller family in Arizona and Texas; a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends including the Feaster
