CURRY, Mr. Otis L. - Age 73, passed away Thursday, February 9, 2012 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 18, 2012 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Morris A. Collins, Sr., officiating, Pastor Patrick Sanders, Host Pastor. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friend and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Mr. Curry will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1-8 p.m. Friday. Mr. Otis Louis Curry was born May 4, 1938 in Bartow, Georgia, the son of Mike Hicks and Rebecca Tarver. Otis was a resident of Flint, Michigan since 1965. He worked for General Motors, retiring in 1991. Mr. Curry was a member in good standing at Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church. He loved watching western movies, fishing, playing spades and bid whist. Mr. Curry also enjoyed traveling to different states. He was the first black Santa Claus in December of 2006 and 2007 in the Flint City Hall.
