TAYLOR, Mr. Otis Junior - Age 86, passed away Monday, December 30, 2019 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Monday, January 6, 2020 at Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, 4805 N. Saginaw Street, with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Rev. Dr. Henry L. Fuller Jr. officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Mr. Taylor will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM Sunday, with the family present from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM to receive friends.

Mr. Otis Junior Taylor, 86 of Flint, Michigan entered eternal rest on Monday, December 30th at his home. Mr. Taylor was born on July 12, 1933 in El Dorado, Arkansas the only son of Odie and Carrie Taylor.

Mr. Taylor retired from General Motors AC Spark Plugs in 1987. At General Motors he started his career as a Stock Boy, then was promoted to Foreman, General Foreman and then Plant Superintendent. He also served on the Genesee County Department of Mental Health Board of Directors for many years.

Mr. Taylor was a devoted member of Mount Calvary Missionary Baptist Church where he served faithfully as a Trustee and in the Music Ministry. He enjoyed playing golf and was supportive of his children's and grandchildren's activities and special events. Mr. Taylor enjoyed traveling with his wife Vertie

When Mr. Taylor would walk into the room, he had an innate ability to connect with all generations (young and old). He would have special saying that he would impart on individuals, such as "Take God with You".

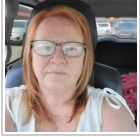

“ There are so many memories I could share about Otis, but my favorite memories are of he and my father, Robert. There was tremendous love between them. Whenever they got together it was loud. It loud like "sitting in front of a speaker at a concert" loud. They really should have had their own decibel measurement. It was even louder when the two of them and my Uncle Roy (Bryant) were together. Roy couldn't hang as well as Otis and Daddy, but he tried.

I think the noise drove my mother a little crazy, but I loved it! Their reunions were seismic, rumbling, boisterous, hellacious fun, starting early in the morning and going well into the night. Sometimes it was propelled by a good drink, but it was mainly two men who just loved each other to death. Whenever Otis left L. A. after a visit, the house was quiet and not nearly as much fun. If it was Daddy, who had come home after a visit, he seemed to get quiet and sentimental.

The first time I remember meeting "Brother" was during a road trip my parents, grandmother and I took. I think Brother's house was the first place we stopped when we got into town. He gave me my first sip of beer- I think I was about ten. I remember him giving me this look like "Lord have mercy! Girl, come and have a sip. It ain't gonna kill you." I've been in love with him ever since.

My mom's favorite memory of Brother was when she and my father flew Flint. Faye knew they were coming but Brother didn't. When they got to her house, they put away their luggage and hid in Faye's bedroom. Faye called Brother and told him she was having problems with a guy and would he please come over. When he got there, Faye was sitting with her head in her hands and told him the guy was in her bedroom. When he got there, and my father opened the door, they hugged each other, jumping up and down and laughing. Brother was so surprised, and they were so happy to see each other, that they fell over on Faye's bed and broke it. For my mom, there was something about that visit that just deepened the love Brother and Daddy had for each other.

To our Flint Family, we love you and hold you in our hearts. Thank you for sharing your husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, uncle and brother with us.

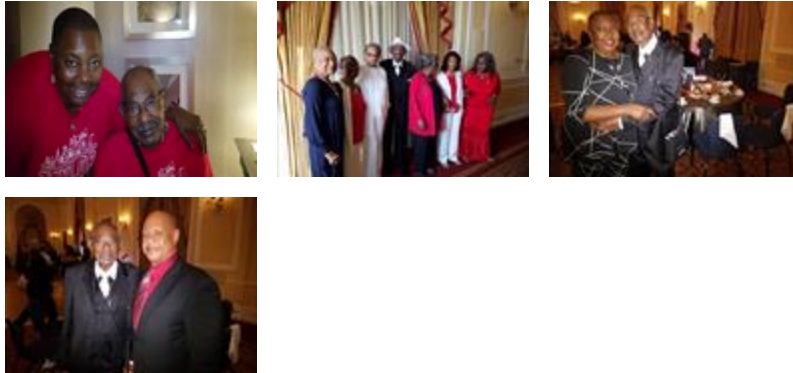
