SCOTT, Sister Patricia - age 49, passed away Wednesday, September 10, 2014 at her residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, September 20, 2014 at Bethlehem Temple Church Of The Apostolic Faith, 3401 M.L. King Ave. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Phillip J. Sister Patricia Annette Scott was born on November 4, 1964 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Lorenzy and Carrie Dell (McFadden) Scott. Patricia graduated from Northern High School, "Class of 1982." During her early years she was a faithful member of Dozier C.M.E. Church where her parents and grandparents were charter members. She came to Bethlehem Temple Church in the early 1990's with her godmother, Mother Gartie McBride; where Patricia was Baptized and filled with the Holy Ghost. Elder Jerry T. Lewis was the pastor whom she loved and adored like a father. Patricia worked faithfully in the church, serving as the Director of BTC Daycare, Director of the Great Start Readiness Program, member of the Missionary Women's Department, the Missionary Choir, Hospitality Committee and Children's Church Director. As Patricia's health failed, she continued her support in many capacities at the church under the leadership of District Elder Phillip J. Thompson. Patricia was
