Olive Baptist Church 5859 Michigan Rd.,(or M-99) with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Rev. Paul W. Garrett, Sr., officiating. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Saturday. Rev. Garrett, Jr. will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Paul was born July 28, 1970 in Lansing, Michigan to Paul Sr. and Ruth Garrett. Paul grew up in Lansing, Michigan and attended Eastern High School in Lansing, Michigan before moving to Flint, Michigan. Paul gave his life to the Lord at a young age and was a dedicated member of Mt. Olive Baptist Church in Lansing, MI for over 20 years where he served as a minister following under the leadership of his father Rev. Paul W. Garrett, Sr. Paul enjoyed working as a salesman.
