Paul was a resident of Flushing, MI and a member of the House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church in Flint, where he served as a former member of the Mass choir and the Men's choir until his health began to fail. In 1991, he retired after 32 years of service from A.C. Spark Plug-Rochester, a division of General Motors Corporation and was a member of UAW Local 651. On June 2, 2004, Paul and Norma Jean Vanzant were united in Holy Matrimony at Genesys Regional Medical Center, located in Grand Blanc, MI.
