Paula moved with her parents to Flint, Michigan in 1955, where she attended Flint Community Schools before moving to Mt. Morris, MI and graduating from Elizabeth Ann Johnson Memorial High School, "Class of 1972." She attended Mott Community College and U of M-Flint, majoring in Social Work, because she wanted to help other in need. Ms. Watson also attended Foss Avenue Baptist Church at an early age, Holy Ghost and Second Genesis Baptist Church, where she served as Treasurer and choir member.
