Her legacy of love, strength, and faith will forever live on in the hearts of everyone she touched.

She will be remembered for her generous heart and her remarkable ability to make everyone feel special and loved. A woman of great resilience, she remained strong and full of grace until the very end of her life. Her final words before going home to be with the Lord were, "I love you too."

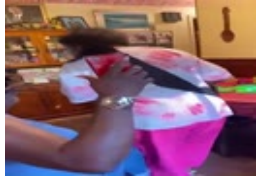
