LOVETT, Mr. Perry - Age 92, passed away Tuesday, April 19, 2011 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 1:30 p.m. Saturday, April 23, 2011 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Mr. Perry Lovett was born December 2, 1918 to the late Bamma and Will Lovett in Eldorado, Arkansas. Mr. Lovett attended the Eldorado, Arkansas school system. He received an Honorable Discharge in 1943 from the U.S. Military Service. Perry moved to Flint, Michigan in 1949. He was employed and retired with 32 years of service from General Motors Buick Assembly Plant. Perry was married to his devoted sweetheart Arlene for 40 years. He joined and was a faithful member servant of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, under the leadership of Bishop Odis A. Floyd. Perry was an avid golfer.
