MARTIN, Mr. Perry - Age 78, passed away Friday, February 22, 2008 at Brian's House. Family hour 10:30AM Saturday, March 1, 2008 at Christ Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church, 317 E. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30AM Saturday. Mr. Martin will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 9AM-8PM Friday. Perry Martin was born June 13, 1929 in Tishomingo, MS. The son of Lonnie and Lillian (Southward) Martin. He accepted Christ at an early age and joined Carter's Branch Missionary Baptist Church of Tishomingo, MS. He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces on June 8, 1955 after serving in the Korean Conflict as a Sergeant. Upon discharge he relocated to Flint, MI where he married Jessie L. Hughes. He was employed at Buick and was a member of Local 1292 for several years before transferring to Fisher Body Grand Blanc; he then retired after many years of service. He united with Foss Avenue Baptist Church under the guidance of Pastor Avery Aldridge, where he was a faithful and dedicated Deacon, and he also served in the Choir and with the Jail Ministry. He was the founder of Martin Trucking Inc. His vision was to own a trucking company that embodied wealth and prosperity for his family and the community of Flint. Perry Martin enjoyed fishing, hunting, and gardening. He had a gentle and sweet spirit along with an infectious smile

that would light up the room. His kids and grandkids were the love of his life. He leaves to cherish his memory: 3 sons, Derry Martin, Lonnell (Tarnesa) Martin, and Johnny (Maryann) Alexander all of Flint; 2 daughters, Penny (Kenneth) Echols and Patrice Martin both of Flint; 1 extended daughter, Nurse Patsy McCaskey; grandchildren, Kenneth Echols Jr., TaQoiya Brown, Jaire Grayer, Lonnell Martin Jr., Darius Martin, Quatia Alexander, Tawana Fleming, Perry J.
