Manney was born September 12, 1961 in Helena, Arkansas, the son of Frank, Sr. and Bobbye Manney. Pervell accepted the Lord as his Savior at an early age and was a faithful member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church. He graduated from Harlem High School. Pervell served in the United States Army for 4 years with an Honorable Discharge. He was formerly employed at Midwest Zinc and a volunteer at McLaren Regional Medical Center.
