Mr. Quennel Charles Banks began his earthly life on January 6, 1984, in Flint, Michigan, the son of Odessa Elliott of Flint and Charles Banks of Atlanta, Georgia. He completed his journey August 16, 2014 in Mesa, Arizona. He grew up in Flint attended the public schools, graduating from Northern High School class of 2002. He later attended Grand Rapids Community College, majoring in Business Administration, graduated in 2004. He was employed by Macy's in Grand Rapids, then transferred to Phoenix, Arizona, and was employed at Phoenix International Airport Hertz Car Rental.
