



## Supt. Quintin Lee Marshall Sr.

March 3, 1957 - July 11, 2018

MARSHALL, Supt. Quintin Lee Sr. - Age 61, passed away Wednesday, July 11, 2018 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, July 21, 2018 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM, Bishop Roger L. Jones Sr., Officiant, Eld. Patrick Sanders Sr., Host Pastor. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 AM Saturday. Supt. Marshall will lie in state at New Life Tabernacle Church Of God In Christ, 5149 N. Bray Rd., and may be viewed from 1:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday.

Superintendent Quintin Lee Marshall Sr. was born March 3, 1957 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Mr. Herman and Arnell (Phinisee) Marshall. He grew in Flint and graduated from Flint Southwestern School, "Class of 1975." Quintin was a star basketball player in high school as well as college. He attended Mott Community College pursuing a degree in Business Administration. Supt. Marshall was a serious person most of the time but could be quite comical too. We all know how he could spin a rhyme at the drop of a dime. I guess we could say he had a gift of "Gab." He was also a persuasive person. Some said that he could sell an Eskimo a furnace. He loved cars, traveling and gospel music. Supt. Marshall was also known for his business acumen, community involvement and as a repository of knowledge for those seeking both spiritual and business information. The business world recognized the ability of Mr. Quintin L. Marshall as he matriculated through the ranks of various Fortune

500 companies, obtaining his first job at Nabisco as a Sales Representative and eventually attaining the rank of an SBC Ameritech Account Executive. Throughout his tenure, Mr. Marshall was awarded numerous awards especially for top sales. Supt. Marshall's gift as a visionary was evident in the myriad of functions he organized, including founding and operating the non-profit Youth Explosion Retreat and Adult Traveling excursions. The Youth Explosion Retreat provided inner city youth the opportunity to be exposed to life across the United States, as well as Canada. While there the youth would be also imparted with the Word of God. Additionally, Supt. Marshall organized and founded the Black Business Expo, the Annual Genesee County Gospel Fest. Among Superintendent Marshall's many accomplishments were being recognized and rewarded with a 2015 Key to City of Flint, honors from the Detroit Chronicles along with honors from both the State Governor's Office and the State House of Representatives. Additionally, he was a published author, former President of the Genesee County C.O.G.I.C. Alliance, former Vice-President of Concerned Pastor's, President of the Flint Area Community Housing and Resource Board. Apart from his family, Supt. Marshall's greatest joy was his relationship with God and the fellowship of the brethren as he worked tirelessly to expand God's Kingdom. Supt. Marshall served in various capacities throughout the Local, District and Jurisdictional Church. Supt. Marshall was the Founder and Pastor of New Life Tabernacle Church of God in Christ for 25 years until his retirement in 2015. Upon appointment by 1st Assistant Presiding Bishop Philip Aquilla Brooks, he served as Superintendent of the Potter's House District. He faithfully served as a son of the Historic First Michigan Northeast Jurisdiction until the decline of his health which limited his travel during which time he was led to transition to Michigan Southeast under the leadership of the Jurisdictional Prelate Bishop Roger L. Jones, Sr. in which he served as an Administrative Assistant as well as a Superintendent. One of Supt. Marshall's greatest joys was the relationship with his wife of 21 years, Queen Esther Marshall. He called her "THE FRENCH IN HIS FRY". Quintin and Queen did not have any children together. They had a blended family of

what they often referred to as “the Brady Bunch.” Queen had 3 sons from a previous marriage and Quintin had 2 daughters and 1 son from a previous marriage. He leaves to cherish his memories, his wife, Queen Esther Marshall. He also leaves to cherish his memories two daughters, Quinice and Sylvie Marshall of Texas; three sons, Pastor Dion Richardson, Damon (Dawn) Richardson and Quintin Marshall, Jr, all of Flint; grandchildren, Sergio and Andrea of Texas, Dion Jr., Cheyenne, Jordan, Deja, DaKhouri, Damon Jr. and DeAria, all of Flint, Ashanti and Symphonie of North Carolina; two sisters, JoeAnne Wilkerson of Seattle, WA and Linda Wortham of Flint, MI; two brothers, Stephen and Dondre Marshall, both of Seattle, WA; aunts, Doris Collins, Lestine (Pete) Gheresus and Margaret Gonzalez, all of Flint, MI; uncles, Bishop Lois (Berdia) Marshall of Gary, IN, Fred (Sarah) Phinisee of Indianapolis, IN, John (Gwen) Phinisee and James (Helen) Phinisee; two sisters-in-law, Gwendolyn Marshall, and Pamela Lane; two brothers-in-law, Terrance (Linda) Lane and Kevin Lane; special friends, Elder Robert (Teresa) Allen, Randy (Judy) Thornton, Steve Malone, Dennis Johnson, Todd Bradley, and Jerry Buterakos; special daughter, Shantel Stone; special sister, Tonya Lane; special nieces, Ticheta Wortham and Tameka Marshall, all of Flint, MI; special nephew, Johanes Wortham; special cousin, Cynthia Houston; the mother of his children, Sylvia Teamer.
