TRAYLOR, Mr. R.B. Jr. - Age 89, passed away Thursday, December 10, 2020 at his residence. Family hour 1:30 PM Saturday, December 19, 2020 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Mr. R.B. Traylor Jr. a.k.a. "Uncle Hot" was born December 21, 1930 in Kirbyville, Texas, the eldest son of five siblings born to R.B. Traylor Sr. and Gladys (Bendy) Traylor. He moved to Flint, Michigan in 1953 and was employed at Buick Motor Company, a division of General Motors Corporation for 39 years prior to retiring in 1994. R.B. was married twice and to the union no children were born. He was a Trustee and President of the Usher Board at St. James CME Church of Flint for over 50 years. R.B. Traylor Jr. was a faithful and dedicated servant. He was a blessing to all who knew him.

Mr. Traylor was preceded in death by his father, R.B. Traylor Sr.; mother, Gladys Traylor; 2 sisters, Sallie L. Brumley and Ruth L. Wright; brother, Johnny Traylor.
