CAMPBELL, Mr. Raymond - Age 66, passed away Saturday, August 27, 2016 at University of Michigan Hospital, Ann Arbor, MI. Mr. Raymond L. Campbell was born January 22, 1950 in Pioneer, Louisiana, the son of Willie E. Williamson and Pauline Campbell. Raymond accepted Christ at an early age while attending New Bethany Baptist Church in Darnell, Louisiana; he graduated from Magnolia High School in Louisiana; after which he moved to Flint, Michigan, in 1968 where he attended Mott Community College.

Mr. Raymond Campbell was employed by General Motors serving as a supervisor and retiring after 25 years of service. After retirement from GM, Raymond began a new career with Catholic Charities serving with the Mr. Rogers Program which was dear to his heart. He served with commitment and tireless love.

Mr. Campbell married the love of his life, Lerlean Pratcher, in 1985. He was a member of Ebenezer Ministries, where he served as a mentor with the Save Our Sons program where he was instrumental in the lives of many youth.
