Rebecca Montreo (Mont) Turner began her earthly journey on March 4, 1923. As the youngest daughter of ten children born to James William and Hattie Zuragay Stewart in Radford, VA. She came to Flint, MI around 1952. Shortly after arriving, Rebecca became a member of Vernon Chapel A.M.E. Church. She remained a member for more than 50 years. Although Rebecca considered leaving Flint due to the Beecher tornado, she stayed. Soon she met and married LeRoy Turner. To this union she gave birth to four daughters. In 1981, Rebecca completed Nursing Assistant training. She retired from housekeeping at the YMCA in 1987 after 18 years of service. Upon retiring,

Rebecca enjoyed spending time with her grandsons, exercising, reading and listening to music. She also volunteered for more than 5,536 hours with the Senior Companion Program.
