ROYSTER, Mr. Richard D. - Age 44, passed away Tuesday, August 7, 2007 at his residence. Family hour 11AM Saturday, August 11, 2007 at Foss Avenue Baptist Church, 1159 E. Foss Ave., with funeral service commencing immediately at 12Noon. Rev. Derrick Aldridge officiating, Dr. Roosevelt Austin, Pastoral Administrator. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Saturday. Mr. Royster will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. (family will receive visitors from 4PM-7PM). Mr. Richard "Rich" Royster was born August 28, 1962 in Flint, Michigan to the union of Peter and Thelma (Callaway) Royster. Richard joined Foss Avenue Baptist Church at an early age. He later became a very proud member of 2nd Chance Church, where he faithfully served as the Media Ministry Coordinator. Richard was educated in Flint Public School System and graduated from Northwestern High School "Class of 1980." He continued his education at Eastern Michigan University and graduated from Spring Arbor University. Richard was employed at New Path's Incorporated as a Residential Advisor.
