CONEY, Mr. Robert T. "Bob" - Age 91, passed away Thursday, May 1, 2008 at his residence. Family hour 10AM Thursday, May 8, 2008 at Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle, 930 E. Myrtle Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11AM, Rev. Woody Etherly, Jr., officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Thursday. Mr. Coney will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 2PM-8PM Wednesday. Mr. Robert T. "Bob" Coney born June 9, 1916 in Pike County, MS, son of the late Ulysses and Lilean Coney. He lived a life fully devoted to the Lord. Mr. Coney was dedicated member and officer at Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle under the leadership of the late Dr. A.J. Pointer. Serving faithfully as Chairman of the Trustee Board, Sunday School Superintendent, President of Senior Choir, teacher of Sunday School class #2 until his health failed and was a member of the Male Choir. "Bob" was educated in Pike County, MS, and later attended Xavier University to become a teacher. Prior to his graduation he was drafted into the U.S. Army during World War II and earned sergeants rank. "Bob" served his country in both France and Germany supplying soldiers in the front line. Upon returning to the states he relocated north to work for General Motors, retiring after 35 years of service. He was President of the Aitken Ave. Block Club for 20 years.
