Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-8PM Thursday. Mr. Robert John "RJ" French was born October 16, 1932 in Rison, Arkansas, the son of Ervin and Patsy French. In 1950 Robert moved from his home in Rison, Arkansas to Flint, Michigan. Shortly after his relocation to Flint he was drafted into the United States Army, where he served in the Korean Conflict. After his tour of duty he returned home to Flint and went to work at Chevrolet Manufacturer, where he worked as a die-setter for 30 years before retiring in 1981. Mr. French was a member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the VFW Committee. Mr. French enjoyed any type of electrical, plumbing and carpentry work, and could always be counted on to fix any household problem you may have.
