Mr. Robert James Jones was born September 22, 1926 to George Jones and Bertha Kline Jones in Vicksburg, Mississippi. In his late teens, he joined the Navy and often talked about his travels, especially Hawaii. After his tour of duty, he moved to Albion, Michigan to work with his father and oldest brother, the late George, Jr. (affectionately nick named "Thin"). He later joined the family to live in Jackson, MI. From there he moved to Flint, where he worked for General Motors until his retirement. Robert has left many cherished memories to remember him by, such as his love for the latest fashions including his Stacey Adams shoes and caps, were at the top of his list. He also loved pinky rings, a good joke (he had a great sense of humor), and our mother's homemade rolls. His favorite hymn was "Until we meet again." The scripture he most often recited was John 14:2-7: Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: If it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will

come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there you will be also. And where I go ye know, and the way ye know. I am the way, truth and the life: No man cometh unto the Father but by me.
