Saginaw St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 12Noon Thursday. Mr. Jones will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Wednesday. Mr. Robert Lee Jones was born November 1, 1932 in Grenada, Mississippi, the son of Edward and Lucy Jones, and grew up in Millington, TN before moving to Flint at the age of 17. He was a longtime, faithful member at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, where he served with the Male Chorus and Trustee Board. Bob sang with several groups including being Manager of the Original Flint Cavaliers, and presently held the position of Booking Manager for the Flint Southernaires. He was employed with Chevrolet Truck & Bus, a division of General Motors Corporation, retiring in 2004 with 51.5 years of service, and was a member of UAW Local 598. Bob was a friendly man who touched many lives, and had a big sense of humor. His favorite past times were bowling, hunting, singing gospel music, and spending time with his family.
