LEE, Mr. Robert Edward Jr. - Age 85, passed away Monday, February 10, 2020 at Medilodge of Grand Blanc. Family hour 10:00 AM Monday, February 17, 2020 at Church of the Harvest, 2202 W. Dartmouth St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Bishop Neal Roberson, officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Monday. Mr. Lee will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM Sunday.

Mr. Robert E. Lee Jr. was born March 19, 1934, in Uvalda, Georgia, the son of the late Robert E. Sr. and Chessie Mae Lee. He married the love of his life, the late Henrietta Lee, in 1955 and later moved to Flint, Michigan. Robert gave his life to the Lord at an early age and then united with Heavenly Host Full Gospel Baptist Church, which became Church of the Harvest International under the leadership of Bishop Neal Roberson. Mr. Lee served faithfully on the Usher Board and sang in the Men's Day choir. Robert Lee was employed by General Motors, where he retired after over 30 years of service. He was a faithful member of Rose of Sharon Lodge #4 A.F. & A.M, The Georgia Peach Club of Flint, Honorary Football Coach at Flint Northern High School, and Honorary Football Coach at Hamady High School. In his early years, Robert was a phenomenal baseball player. Mr. Lee was a master gardener, enjoyed watching sports, reading the newspaper, planning family reunions, fishing, dancing, repairing cars, "fixing things," traveling to sporting

events with his sons, and being a “Jack of Many Trades.” The rhythm of his heartbeat was his beloved family. He LOVED family time and Christmas with his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Affectionately known as “Junior” and “Uncle Bobbo” by his friends and family, “Poppa Lee” to the athletes of Flint, but the names he absolutely adored being called was “Daddy” and “Papa” by the apples of his eye. Robert Lee worked hard for his family, was an awesome man of God, and touched the lives of many people. Family and friends will greatly miss him. Memories of him will be cherished by all the hearts he touched.

Mr. Lee was preceded in death by his parents, Robert E. Sr. and Chessie Mae Lee; his beloved wife of 61 years, Henrietta Lee; sister, Hazel Williams; mother and father-in-law, Dewitt and Gussie Hall.
