Public View will be held only during the family hour. Mr. Robert Melton Rose "Bobby" was born May 17, 1938 in Columbus, Ohio, the son of Margaret (Paul) Rose and David Blair. Robert was a resident of Flint Twp., Michigan for 25 years. He was a member of the Evangelistic Temple Church of the Apostolic Faith where he served as the Chief Parking Lot Attendant, Choir Member and Brotherhood Department Historian. Robert retired after 30 years of service from Ronald Reagan Airport (formally Dallas Airlines) working for United Airlines. He was a world traveler, visiting Belgium, France, Germany, England and Hawaii. 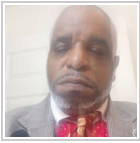
