Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Wednesday. Mr. Robert A. Wardlow was born October 27, 1915 in Ripley, Tennessee, the son of James and Helen (Woods) Wardlow. Robert was an active member of Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle for 67 years, serving as Sunday School Teacher, Sunday School Superintendent, Trustee Deacon and most recently on the Library Committee. He loved fishing, studying and teaching the Bible. Robert taught at various churches around the city as well as at the National, State, and District Baptist Congress. He retired from General Motors in 1976, after 30 years of service. For over 20 years, he worked at Sunshine Bible Store, as a consultant and advisor, which he really enjoyed. Robert often stated that "If I can't read and study my Bible, I don't won't to be here". He was a 33rd degree Mason and a past member of Rose of Sharon Masonic Lodge. Mr. Robert A.
