She was a graduate of Sussex Central High School, "Class of 1972." Very close to her siblings who had moved to Michigan, Roberta soon followed moving to Flint in 1973. She later attended Lansing Community College and graduated in 1986. Roberta was employed at Grand Blanc Rehab and Nursing Center for 17 years where she served as Director of Food Services. In 1996 Roberta began attending Promise Tabernacle® (at that time, Golden Leaf Baptist Church). Being led by the Holy Spirit to receive Jesus as Lord of her life she united with the church family in 2001. Roberta loved her pastor, Frederick L. Flowers, Sr., his teachings, and her church family.
