WYNNE, Mr. Roger - Age 72, passed away Tuesday, May 25, 2010 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 11 a.m. Thursday, June 3, 2010 at Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, 2109 M.L. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8 p.m. Wednesday. Mr. Roger E. "Sonny" Wynne, Sr. was born February 10, 1938 in Dyersburg, Tennessee, the son of Mack and Belvie Wynne. Roger accepted Christ at an early age. He moved to Flint upon graduating from high school. "Sonny" served in the U.S. Army and was Honorably Discharged. He united with Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church and was a past member of the Masonic Order, PHA. Roger was employed by Flint Metal Fab, a division of General Motors for 33 years, retiring as a General Supervisor in 1988. On December 15, 1962, he was united in marriage to Onie Jean Flippen and to this union 2 children were born, Crystal and Roger, Jr. His wife, children, grandchildren and family were the love and joy of his life. "Sonny's" hobbies included golfing, traveling, viewing all sporting events and being a full-time carpenter.
