WYNN, Mr. Roosevelt "Buddy" - Age 76, passed away Monday, June 6, 2011 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10 a.m. Monday June 13, 2011 at Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, G-4805 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Dr. Henry L. Fuller, Jr., officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Monday. Mr. Wynn will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday. Mr. Roosevelt "Buddy" Wynn began his earthly journey on July 13, 1934, the son of Wiley and Eva Wynn in Rison, Arkansas. "Buddy" grew up in Rison, attending the Public Schools there. He resided in St. Louis, MO before coming to Flint in 1953. "Buddy" returned to Rison and was joined in Holy Matrimony to his true love, Julia. From this union 3 daughters were born. He was employed at Buick City, a division of General Motors, retiring after 42 years of service and was a member of UAW Local #599. "Buddy" was an avid bowler, fisherman, realist and conversationalist, snazzy dresser with an infectious smile, who loved his family and taught them well. He began his Christian journey after accepting Christ at an early age. "Buddy" united with Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church in 1960 and served faithfully in the Music Ministry.
