Mrs. Rosa Bell Haywood, affectionately known as Rose was born in Greensboro, North Carolina on May 8, 1922 according to the family Bible. She was the youngest daughter of Paul Washington and Bennie Sprinkle and on Friday May, 8, 2015. She quietly transitioned to her eternal home. Educated in the Guilford County School System in Greensboro, North Carolina. Rose graduated from Dudley High School. She and her sister Bessie were known in Greensboro as "the Washington Girls." The two sisters were inseparable and both played on the basketball team and enjoyed attending dances at the Palace. Rose was remembered as the quiet sister who always wore a smile. Following graduation Rose met and married the love of her life, Jesse O'Neal Haywood and from this union her oldest son was born in Greensboro. Upon Jesse's discharge from the Army Air Corp, the family moved to Washington D.C. then the family moved once again to New York City before finally settling

permanently in Flint Michigan. In Flint, Rose gave birth to Vincent and Tammie Haywood. Rose was the consummate homemaker, she also loved gardening and basketball. Following her husband's death in 1975, at 54 years of age, she began her career at AC Spark Plugs, a division of General Motors where she continued working until her retirement. Grandma Rosie had a special place in the heart for her grandchild Nicole Pacada and great-grandson Craig Sutters. Together they shared a love of reading, jazz, and the Chicago Bulls!
