HILL, Mr. Roscoe W, Sr. - Age 88, went home to be with the Lord, August 14, 2005 at Genesys Hospice Center. Family hour 12:30PM Thursday, August 18, 2005 at Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle, 930 E. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Wednesday. Mr. Roscoe W. Hill, Sr. was born on December 31, 1916 in Edmonson, Arkansas, the son of Joseph and Ollie (Dove) Hill. Mr. Hill moved to Flint as a teenager. He was a Charter Member of Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle. Mr. Hill graduated from Northern High School and was a Honorably Discharged Veteran of the U.S. Army, serving during WWII. He retired from Buick, a division of General Motors Corporation and was a member of the UAW Local 599. Mr. Roscoe W.
