



## Ms. Roshetta Ann Monroe

April 30, 1968 - June 1, 2018

MONROE, Ms. Roshetta - Age 50, passed away Friday, June 1, 2018 at her residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, June 23, 2018 from from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Ms. Roshetta Ann Monroe was born on April 30, 1968 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Edna R. (Pringle) and Wendell B. Monroe Sr. As a teenager, Roshetta accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Savior. She attended Flint Public Schools and went on to attend Job Corps in Grand Rapids, Michigan where she earned a certificate in Welding. A few years later she became a CNA working at several nursing homes, one of the first being Marion Hall. Ms. Monroe's vibrant and compassionate personality touched the lives of those around her. She would often help family and friends clean, which she felt was therapeutic. Even though her frame was petite, Roshetta was very strong. She frequently rearranged furniture alone when bored. She also loved to eat and didn't mind cooking up some greens, black- eyed peas and baked chicken just as long as you stayed to eat so she didn't have to eat alone. As part of her daily ritual she would read the Bible, most often verses in Psalms. Roshetta has lived in quite a few places during her life. After relocating back to Michigan from Iowa for a couple of years, she began caring for her father with her sister.
