



Pastor Rosie Mae Richardson

October 10, 1943 - July 5, 2014

RICHARDSON, Pastor Rosie Mae - age 70, passed away Saturday, July 5, 2014 at McLaren-Flint. Family hour 10 a.m. Friday, July 11, 2014 at Southeast Christian Church of The Apostolic Faith, 4171 Lapeer Rd., Burton, MI. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Rev. Henry Thompson officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Friday. Pastor Richardson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 12 p.m.-8 p.m. Thursday.

Pastor Rosie Mae Richardson was born in Inverness, MS on October 10, 1943 to Bishop Roosevelt and Earslen Sims. In 1945, Roosevelt and Earslen moved to Flint, MI where Rosie resided. All of her friends and loved ones knew her as Rose. She was raised in Holy Key Church of All Faith where Bishop R. H. Sims pastored. Rosie worked for the Flint Board of Education and retired with 30 years of service. During her life, Rose had many accomplishments: She went back to high school and obtained her diploma, she was ordained as an Evangelist under Bishop R. H. Sims, she graduated from Faith Tech Bible College and Full Gospel Christian Church Bible College and Theology Seminary and International Seminary. Rosie pastored Holy Key Church of All Faith after her father passed and later renamed it to Keys of the Kingdom Ministries where she pastored until 2010. She was a member of the Victorious Christian Women (VCW). In addition, Rose sang in a gospel quartet

group for many years, the “Gospel Keys” and was honored to emcee many quartet group anniversaries. Her passions were praising God, helping the sick, the lost and studying the Word of God. Rosie was known for her compassion, truthfulness, understanding, wisdom and dependability. She was a caregiver, counselor, hard worker and a great cook. Although she was known for many wonderful things, we remembered her for the love she showed her family and friends and that’s something we will never forget, our guardian angel. Her church membership was with Kingdom Life Ministries International under Bishop Alvernis Johnson. In her last few remaining months, she was attending Southeast Christian Church where Pastor Kenneth M. Brown is the Sr. Pastor.
