Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1-8p.m. Thursday with family present from 4-8p.m. Mr. Rosmond Hobbs was born on September 15, 1931 in Yazoo City, Mississippi, the son of William and Leola Hobbs. He resided in the city of Flint, Michigan. Mr. Hobbs was a former faithful member of St. Agnes Catholic Church, where he served on the Finance Committee and Usher Board before becoming a member of St. John Vianney Parish Catholic Church. Mr. Hobbs grew up in Yazoo City Mississippi, where he attended and graduated from St. Francis Catholic School. Later to continue his education he attended Delta College while working at General Motors. He married the beautiful Geraldine Lewis June 19, 1955. They enjoyed 55 years of marriage and to this union seven children were born. Rosmond was a U.S. Army Veteran and served during the Korean Conflict from 1947 to 1953, receiving an Honorable Discharge. He was employed with V-8 Engine Plant a division of General Motors, retiring with over 30 years of service and was a member of Local 659. Rosmond began in the sanitation department and promoted himself to a Committee man then on to Foreman. He enjoyed fishing, hunting,

gardening and working on cars, as well as his annual vacations to visit family in Mississippi.
