JONES, Mr. Roy John - Age 71 passed away Sunday, January 17, 2021.

Mr. Jones was Honorably Discharged from the United States Air Force. Mr. Roy John Jones was born January 7, 1950 in Flint, Michigan, the 5th son 11 children born to John Jones and Sarah (Love) Jones. Roy accepted Christ and was baptized at an early age. He graduated from Flint Central High School, "Class of 1968." Roy joined the United States Air Force, with outstanding performance in Aircraft Maintenance. He received an award at the 1971 Sac Combat Competition, Maintenance Man of the Month Award, November 1972, for Outstanding Performance and Superior Leadership Qualities. Roy received an Honorable Discharge from the US Airforce-410 Organizational Maintenance Squadron at a Rank of Sergeant, on February 15, 1973. He retired from Air Products in Chicago, IL.
