OZIER, Mr. Roy, Sr. - Age 82, passed away Monday, March 8, 2010 at his residence. Family hour 11 a.m. Monday, March 15, 2010 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 1083 E. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-8PM Sunday. Mr. Roy Lee Ozier, Sr. was born October 26, 1927 in Pinson, Tennessee, the son of John and Gracie Ozier. Roy moved to Michigan in 1951, where he resided in Kalamazoo, later moving to Flint in 1964. He accepted Christ at an early age, beginning his Christian walk at Beechgrove AME Church in Pinson, Tennessee and later joining Second Baptist Church in Kalamazoo, MI. Roy was a faithful member of Rising Star Missionary Baptist Church of Flint until he became ill, under the leadership of Pastor Chester Payton. He served on the Mission Ministry and sang in the Male Chorus. Roy displayed a loyal commitment to his faith, laboring for many years through song; singing in numerous quartet groups including, The Flint Cavaliers, The Flint All-Stars, Aires of Harmony, The Paramounts, The Bright Stars, The Silver Aires and Once Upon A Time. He was known to many as "Big D", "Ra-La-Oa-Za", and "R.L.".
