Scott and Rueben Arthur, Sr. on December 11, 1929. She was the sixth of seven children. Ruby completed her education in Arkansas. In 1940, Ruby met her first love, John Henry Wicker. In 1941, John and Ruby were joined in marriage. To this union seven children were born: Allan, Curtis, Oliver, Clifton, Donald Ray, Julia and Sylvester. Ruby prided herself on being a stay-at-home mom. In the 1950's Ruby joined the Middle Night Church. Her children enjoyed going to church with their mother, but the services would last all day. These were good times for the family. After John Wicker made his transition to be with God in 1962, Ruby moved her family from Saginaw, Michigan to Flint, Michigan to be closer to her family. For ten years they provided love and support for their family. After a courageous battle with cancer John succumbed to his illness in the late 70's. After a lengthy battle with cancer he was called home. Ruby was preceded in death by her parents; Rosie L.
