Mother Ruth Mae (Harrison) Cannon was born February 4, 1918 in Townville, South Carolina, the daughter of Joseph and Eunice (Harrison) Webb. She received her formal education in South Carolina. Mother Cannon relocated to Flint, Michigan at an early age, and had been a resident for over 75 years. She united in Holy Matrimony with Deacon Kidney Cannon on August 6, 1957. Mother Cannon was a member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church, where she served as Chairman of the Trustee Board for many years. She also served on the Missionary Society, Drama Club, Deaconess Board and Senior Choir.
