LAMARR, Ms. Sabrina - Age 57, passed away Monday, February 23, 2015 at Genesys Health Park – Grand Blanc. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Friday, February 27, 2015 at New Creation Church of God, 3472 Lennon Rd. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Carl Baker officiating. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Friday. Interment Sunset Hills Association, 4413 Flushing Rd. Ms. LaMarr will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. oon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 p.m.-8 p.m. Thursday.

Sabrina R. LaMarr was born in Flint, MI on August 12, 1957 to Mattie (Mott) and Robert LaMarr. After graduating from Central High School, she worked at AC Spark Plug for five years. From a young age Sabrina had a love of music and began studying the saxophone. As a teenager she actually began playing in a band called the HyperSolMystics which was formed by cousins, Kevin, Michael and Calvin Donan. She became an accomplished saxophonist and continued to pursue her music career full time. She led local Flint bands, Two Steps Higher and Level 5 and also played with several Detroit area bands, including Straight Ahead and Notorious to name a few. She performed at many venues including the iconic Baker's Keyboard Lounge and Bert's Place in Detroit, MI. Sabrina was a devoted Christian and was involved in the music ministry of many local churches in Flint. She performed nationally as well as locally. Sabrina was

known for her witty personality and her desire to share her love of music with others. On February 23, 2015 Sabrina passed away at Genesis Hospital after a yearlong battle with cancer. She will be missed for her wit, humor and the impact she had on all our lives. She will also be missed by her many beloved musical colleagues and friends.

She was preceded in death by her father, Robert LaMarr and mother, Mattie LaMarr. She is survived by aunt, Emma Hairston, uncles, Johnny Mott and Donald Mott, devoted cousins, Michelle Gray, Cliff Hairston II, Craig Gray, Jasmine Mott, Syretta Moore, Edward Jackson, Jr and Diane Jackson-Richards.

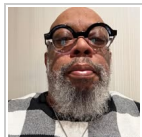

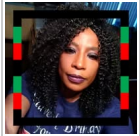
