JONES, Mr. Sam, - Age 95 ½, passed from this life to a peaceful rest on Friday, December 14, 2007 with his daughter Elvira (Elly) by his side praising GOD. Family hour 10AM Saturday, December 21, 2007 at Bethlehem Temple Apostolic Church, 3401 M.L. King, with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Pastor Phillip J. Thompson officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Saturday. Mr. Jones will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Mr. Sam Jones was born, May 1, 1912 in Columbus, Mississippi to the late Zack and Ida (Sims) Jones. He was raised and educated in Mississippi. Mr. Jones fell in LOVE and married Ms. Elmira (Little) on December 21, 1940 in Greenwood, Mississippi. To this union, 8 children were born. He was employed at Buick for 30+ years, retiring in 1976. He was a faithful member of Bethlehem Temple Church for over 30 years. Mr. Jones enjoyed fishing, gardening, Bible study and most recently visits from family and friends.
